What is Entrada?

The Entrada platform provides the go to location for all resources for the Medical Undergraduate Program (MDUP). In addition to storing resources and providing links to other applications, Entrada provides a course schedule and curriculum map.

Who is this guide for?

This guide is intended for year one students, but it also will be useful for year 2 students, faculty and staff.

8 Tasks

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Task 3: Download resources for the week

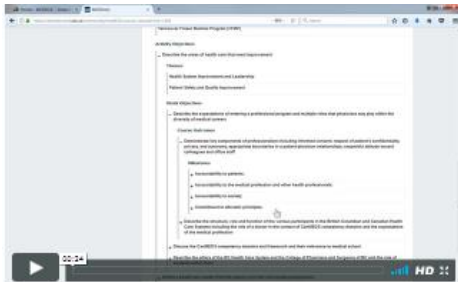
Go to the weeks tab and select a week

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Task 4: Curriculum search

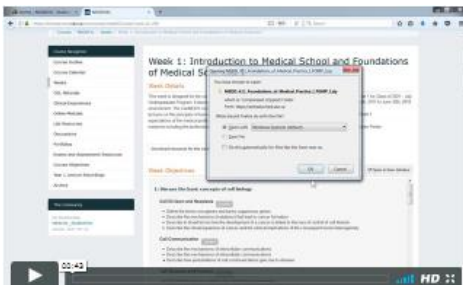
You able to search the curriculum for the first 2 years by topic.

Your Task: Go to the search tab at the top of the dashboard screen.

Enter a topic in the search window.

Note: You can display your results as text, as a table or on a time line. You can also export your results as a CSV file.

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Task 5: Don't get lost in MEDICOL or other applications

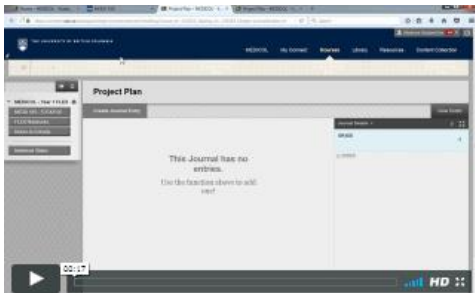
The MDUP program is in the process of transitioning to the Entrada platform from a previous system called MEDICOL.

The transition will be completed by Summer 2018. In the meantime, students will be obliged to access certain tools and resources inside the old MEDICOL application. A good example is in MEDD 419 - FLEX.

Your Task: Go to MEDD 419 and click on the *FLEX Notebook* link in the left hand menu. Click on the *Project Plan Folder* link and it will take you to MEDICOL.
